Frazer Police were contacted to investigate reports of a malnourished dog at the pet store inside the mall. A veterinarian was contacted to aide in the investigation.



#### **THEFT INVESTIGATION**

I got to take part in this investigation. Three men were using a stolen car to steal from Walmart.

A Homewood woman is accused of using a stolen car to steal merchandise from the Walmart in the Pittsburgh Mills shopping complex.

Frazer police charged Janlynn Marie Jordan, 31, with receiving stolen property, retail theft, criminal conspiracy, and traffic violations in connection with the incident at about 6:40 p.m. Wednesday.

Jordan allegedly drove two other people to the Walmart in Frazer and, together, the three stole more than \$500 worth of merchandise, court documents say.

The two other suspects are Deondra Shree Bundy and Shane Evans.

Bundy, 30, of Pittsburgh's Garfield neighborhood, faces charges of criminal conspiracy, retail theft and defiant trespassing.

Online court records for Evans weren't immediat available Thursday afternoon.

Two Philadelphia men are accused of stealing nearly \$41,000 worth of cellphones last month from the Walmart store in Frazer, and they are suspected in similar thefts in at least two other states.

"This is the biggest theft we've ever had at that Walmart by far. It is the largest singular incident of retail theft that we've ever had in Frazer," said township police Chief Terry Kuhns.

James J. Jordan, 42, and Jahmir Andre Mitchell, 19, face felony charges of participating in a corrupt organization, receiving stolen property and retail theft and a misdemeanor conspiracy charge. They remain at large.

As of Tuesday afternoon, police had not filed charges against a third man believed to have been involved in the alleged heist.

Court paperwork outlining the charges against Jordan and Mitchell say police responded to Walmart ea Dec. 18 for a reported shoplifting in progress. Three
