



Renaissance Volleyball Club






Here is the practice gym where we practice on pictures 1 and 3, picture 2 is the entrance to the coaches office space.









Pictures 1 and 3 show the exterior of the Practice facility, picture 2 is where all *Renaissance* teams work out (lift/conditioning) during their practice block.

Some pictures after our first official win as a team! We ended 2nd in bronze this tournament.






The girls huddling up mid match (something we taught that is important after each point)!
